Chairperson of the International Board of Trustees

Prof. Dr. Ishmael L. Togbah

Vice Chairperson

Supports the Chairperson in carrying out Board responsibilities and presides over meetings in the Chairperson's absence.

Secretary to the International Board

Responsible for maintaining official Board records, preparing meeting agendas and minutes, coordinating Board communications, and ensuring compliance with governance procedures.

Treasurer

Mrs. Francess D. Togbah Provides oversight of the University's financial accountability, reviews financial reports, advises on fiscal sustainability, and supports responsible stewardship of institutional resources.

Member, Academic Affairs and Quality Assurance Committee

Provides expertise in higher education, academic policy, curriculum development, institutional effectiveness, and quality assurance.

Member, International Partnerships and Global Engagement Committee

To Be Appointed

Promotes international collaborations, institutional partnerships, exchange opportunities, and global educational initiatives.

Member, Finance and Development Committee

To Be Appointed

Supports strategic financial planning, institutional development, fundraising initiatives, investment strategies, and resource mobilization.

Member, Legal Affairs and Governance Committee

Advises the Board on legal compliance, governance policies, institutional regulations, and ethical standards.

Member, Research, Innovation, and Technology Committee

Provides guidance on research initiatives, technological innovation, digital transformation, artificial intelligence, and academic advancement.

Member, Student Affairs and Community Engagement Committee

Promotes student success, leadership development, community engagement, student welfare, and institutional outreach.

International Member-at-Large

Represents the interests of international stakeholders and contributes expertise to support the University's global mission and strategic objectives.
